Free Methodist Church Prayer Focus

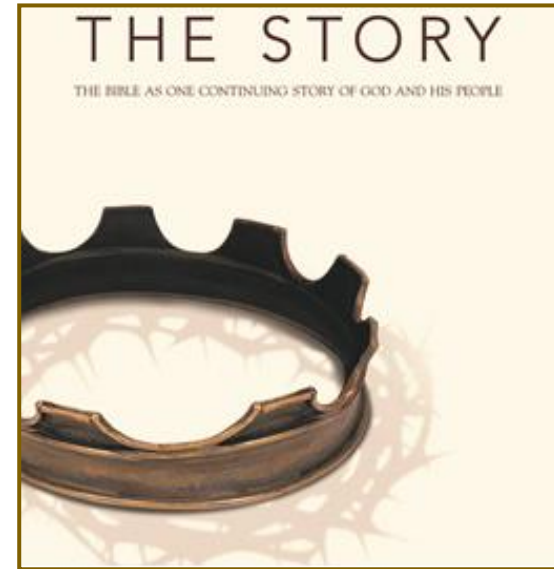
This week's prayer focus is **The Corner Church**, Oshawa, ON. Please remember our brothers and sisters in Christ in your prayers this week.

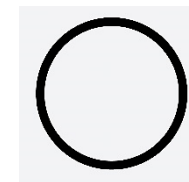
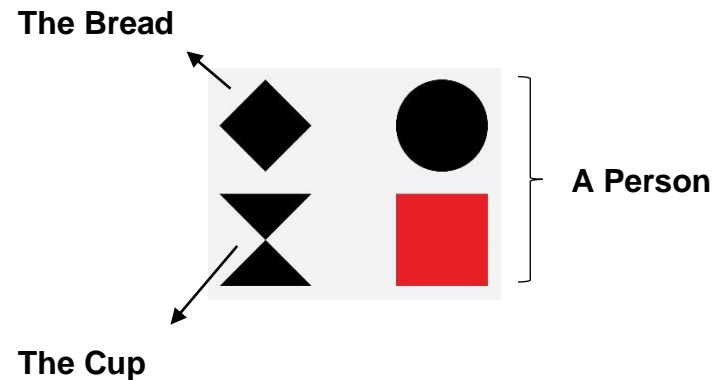
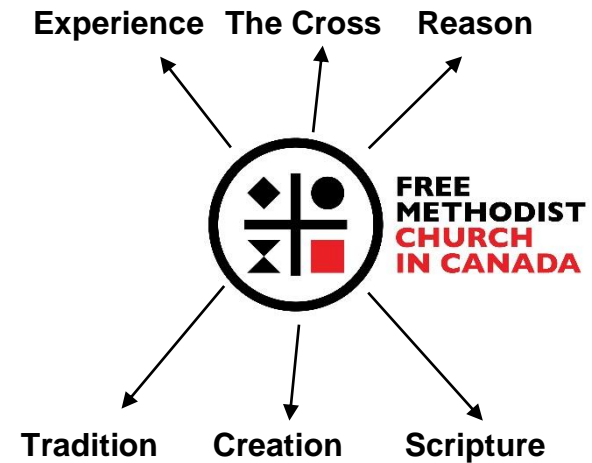
What the logo means

The logo is made up of 5 symbols:

- The diamond represents Experience.
- The circle represents Reason.
- The hourglass represents Tradition.
- The square represents the cornerstone of Scripture.
- The circle around it all represents Creation.
- The crux symbolizes the Cross. The symbols combine to depict a person serving or receiving communion.
- The diamond represents the bread.
- The hourglass represents the cup or wine/juice.
- Together, the circle of reason and square of scripture form a person.

This is not an exhaustive list; since the revealing of the logo, many have made other observations about the elements contained within the logo.

Each component of the new FMCIC logo reflects defining elements of modern Methodism. It contains deep meaning and symbolism and reflects values that are important to our Free Methodist ideology.
