The General Conference at its meeting via Zoom on Feb. 20th voted to rename Global Missions to Intercultural Missions. We want to help the church grow in empathy through the power of the Holy Spirit. We want to help educate those humble enough to learn from and not just about another culture. And we want to help equip faithful followers of Jesus to move and be mobilized to meet the needs of the other."
